CANVASSING BOARD BUSINESS:

- ❖ Meeting called to order at 4:00 P.M. by Mayor Hudson. Mayor Hudson introduced Canvassing Board members.
- ❖ There was no public comment.
- ❖ Mrs. Walker advised there were no provisional ballots for this election and there were five Vote-By-Mail ballots that were pending, four awaiting receipt of signature cure affidavits and one awaiting review by the Board due to signature difference. Seal #21561828 containing five pending ballots was broken. The ballot with signature difference was reviewed by the Board. Motion by Ms. Cox to reject ballot with signature on envelope significantly different from signature on file. Second by Mrs. Walker. Motion carried unanimously.
- ❖ At 5:00 P.M., SOE staff advised no signature cure affidavits had been received. Ms. Cox moved to reject the four VBM pending ballots. Motion carried unanimously.

- ❖ Mrs. Walker reviewed law regarding recount threshold and advised this election differential was 1.20 percent; therefore, no recount is necessary.
- ❖ SOE Walker moved that Chris Dzadoovsky be certified as the winner of this runoff election. Second by Ms. Cox. Motion carried unanimously.
- ❖ Board signs off on today's documentation and same was placed in box under Seal #101-003 and placed in cage under Seal #0648340, after having broken Seal #0862697.
- ❖ Mrs. Walker announced next meeting will be on January 21, 2026, to conduct audit.
- ❖ Ms. Cox made motion to adjourn the meeting. Second by Mrs. Walker. Motion carried unanimously.
- ❖ Meeting adjourned at 5:18 P.M.
