The deadline to register to vote is Monday, July 20, 2026, for the upcoming August 18, 2026, Primary Election. St. Lucie County residents can conveniently register to vote 24 hours a day at www.stlucievotes.gov. Supervisor Walker stated, "With the voter registration deadline quickly approaching, voters should take this time to ensure they are Election Ready and make sure that their voice is heard for the Primary Election".

Residents can register online at www.stlucievotes.gov until midnight on Monday, July 20, 2026, to be eligible to vote in the Primary Election. The following options are also available on the website:
